On this day, we pledge to maintain friendly ties between our time in our common political groups, to promote all areas in trade between our members and supporters to develop a better understanding, feeling alive the environmentalist European brotherhood, our efforts to help in the full measure of our resources to the success of this necessary business development and ecological values for European unity.
